He would appreciate if you had some new research results to present at this outstanding conference place in Europe! Participants in his sessions will have the \$135 paper submission fee waived. (Registration fees, however, are not waived.)

The deadline for submissions to Hubert (gab@iwh-halle.de) is 1 November. It remains extremely important to encourage the development of conference papers into publishable manuscripts.

Your paper abstract (500 word limit) should include: (1) Title (80 character limit); (2) Objectives; (3) Data/Methods; (4) Results/Expected Results Further are needed (5) Name of each author; (6) Affiliation; (7) Address; (8) phone, fax, e-mail;

A limited number of grants are available to help defray part of the registration fees for attending our European conferences. The amounts range from \$100.00 - \$150.00, depending on need. Letter of application should include: (1) Name; (2) Affiliation; (3) Rank; (4) Yearly income range: (less than \$20,000); (\$20,000 - \$29,999); (\$30,000 - \$44,999); (over \$45,000); (5) Biographical Sketch limited to 2 pages (e.g., education, key publications).
Deadline for grant applications: 31 December, 2007.
